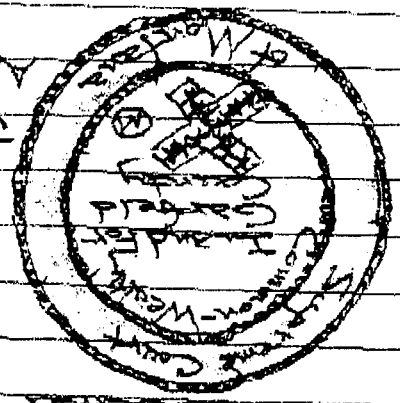

Article IV provides for the Guardian ad litem
to receive temporary custody of the prisoner who
gives written request for temporary custody of the
prisoner after sending a duly verified record.

And, parties where the prisoner is incarcerated. And,
Article V (b) The Guardian ad litem shall present
the following upon demand: (1) Proper identification
and evidence of authority to act for the State
into whose custody this prisoner is to be given.

And (2) a duly verified copy of the pending Court
action in the Common-Wealth. And (c) at the
earliest practicable time consonant with the
purpose of this agreement, the prisoner shall be
returned to the sending State meaning Justice
township.

Article IX shows: "This agreement shall be
liberally construed so as to effectuate its purposes."
